



PET APPLICATION CHECKLIST

1. Completed Dog Application Form
2. Completed Pet Application Acknowledgement Form
3. Provision of a photograph of the completed dog vaccination certificate
4. Provision of a photograph of the dog
5. Provision of a copy of the Council Registration
6. Certificate of de-sexing / neutering of the dog
 - a. If the dog is not de-sexed at time of application, the Owners Corporation will give conditional permission for the dog to reside in the building; however, approval of the dog will not be granted until proof of desexing is provided. A letter from the veterinarian to confirm the intended date of desexing must be provided. If confirmation of de-sexing is not provided within the agreed timeline, the approval will not be granted, and the dog must leave the building.
 - b. The dog must be desexed no later than 18-months of age
7. If you are a renter, you must get your landlord to complete the NSW Fair Trade application form; “Apply to keep a pet in a rental property”
